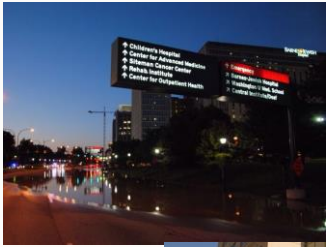

Barnes Jewish Hospital

Barnes Jewish Hospital (BJH) is an academic medical center and level one trauma center in the city of St. Louis. Partnered with Washington University School of Medicine, BJH is licensed for 1200 adult acute care inpatient beds and provides comprehensive outpatient services. Barnes Jewish is consistently rated by *U.S. News and World Report* as one of the top hospitals in the United States. Barnes Jewish encourages the I-CARE values of Integrity, Compassion, Accountability, Respect, and Excellence.

The Spiritual Care Services staff at BJH is multicultural, diverse, and consists of experienced board certified chaplains. The department includes a director, manager, ACPE Educator, ACPE Educator Candidate, an evening supervisor, a project administrator, 14 day and triage chaplains, 2 CPE residents, and several extended and intern CPE student chaplains. The department is currently located in the Mid-Campus Center (MCC), Suite 4205, on the BJH main campus. Our CPE Classroom is located on the 4th floor of the MCC, Room 4201.

CLINICAL PASTORAL EDUCATION

Barnes Jewish Hospital Clinical Pastoral Education is offered under the direction of ACPE Certified Educator Rev. James A. Bennett, D. Min. He has supervised CPE for over twenty years and has both chaplain and congregational experience. Rev. Crystal Schmalz, M.Div., BCC is an ACPE Certified Educator Candidate who works with the summer and extended CPE students. She has been in both chaplaincy and congregational ministry for the past fifteen years. CPE has been offered at BJH for more than forty-five years and has a long history of learning, education, and training leaders for both professional chaplaincy and congregational ministry. We are excited to offer CPE and hope you will consider joining our program!



PART-TIME FALL EXTENDED UNITS

Barnes Jewish offers part time extended programs, which typically range from 20-28 week programs where a group of 5-6 students meets once per week for group and have 10-15 hours of clinical responsibility. These groups offer students the opportunity for group projects, didactics, verbatim presentation, and sacred storytelling opportunities. Scholarships for partial tuition reimbursement are available through the St. Louis Cluster. In 2017-2018, BJH will offer two fall extended units.

11 WEEK SUMMER INTENSIVE UNITS

Barnes Jewish offers full time summer intensive units for students who want to complete a unit of CPE in three months. This unit is a 40-hour per week commitment with weekend and overnight on call opportunities. Students meet twice weekly for group, have verbatim presentations, didactics, role play scenarios, and participate on their clinical units every day. Scholarships for partial tuition reimbursement are available through the St. Louis Cluster.

RESIDENCY:

Barnes Jewish offers a 54-week residency program at BJH, which includes an annual stipend. Our residents meet weekly with their group, which consists of different members of the St. Louis Cluster acute care track. Residents enjoy employee benefits (health insurance, paid time off for vacation and sick leave, and other employee discounts) and have the opportunity to complete 3 or 4 units of CPE throughout the year.
